- 2) What were the circumstances of your coming to Christ (26:13-17)?
 - a. Approximately how old were you?
 - b. Was there someone specifically who God used in your life?
 - c. How do you remember feeling when you trusted Christ as Lord.

- 3) Describe the difference Christ made in your life (26:18-23).
 - a. Are there activities or things you used to do that have been replaced by something else?

 - b. How is God using you for His glory and the good of others?
 - c. What role does the Bible play in your daily walk with Christ?

- 4) Exercise boldness in sharing your testimony but persuade and invite others to the joy of knowing Jesus (26:19-29).
- a. What are ways we can share our salvation testimony with friends while practicing social distancing?
 - b. Include in your testimony an invitation to come to Christ.
 - c. Point people to Jesus.
